

## Tech Talk

*This class provides an overview of a variety of technology tools and resources. These are simple, relatively inexpensive options you can run from your tablet or phone. This is a very basic and introductory class designed to introduce you to some available options and how you might consider applying them. We'll also talk about the purpose of these tools and how to discern their use and application from a leadership perspective.*

### TERMS & DEFINITIONS:

**Metronome:** aka click (or click track) - a device that produces a click at a regular interval of time. You set the desired tempo based on the song’s beats-per-minute (bpm) and meter. Mechanical metronomes, which have been around for several centuries, have a pendulum that swings back and forth. You can also use an electronic metronome or even a metronome app on your phone.

**Guide:** a recorded speaking vocal track that counts into the song and also helps the band navigate the song map by identifying each section just before they need to play it.

**Loop:** A music loop is a section of a piece of music cut in such a way that it can be seamlessly repeated indefinitely by technical means. Loops can range from a few seconds to many minutes in length.

**Tracks/Multitracks:** the recorded separate, individual elements of an audio production.

**Stems:** stereo recordings sourced from mixes of multiple individual tracks. For instance, all of the drum and percussion tracks mixed into a single stem. Or all of the keys tracks, etc.

**Pads:** Pads (or pad loops) are continuous, textured sounds that add layers of depth, feel, and emotion to your music.

**Patches:** preset keyboard sounds you can purchase and import into a software program such as MainStage, Abelton or Onmisphere.

**DAW:** Digital Audio Workstation. Software programs used to create and play music. Ex: Ableton, Logic Pro, GarageBand, Pro Tools, etc.

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## PADS

Gear/Set-up:

- An iPhone or iPad to run the app / audio jack adapter as needed / set to 'do not disturb' or use in airplane mode
- A 1/8" male to 1/4" male cable
- A direct box & an XLR cable (the same way you would plug a guitar or piano into your system)

Featured Apps: **Tempo** or **Playback**. Both of these apps are inexpensive, user-friendly and allow you to set up playlists, which is essential for live performance. Playback has a bit more functionality and can also be paired with pads and/or tracks.

Gear/Set-up:

- An in-ear monitor system
- An iPhone or iPad to run the app / audio jack adapter as needed / 'do not disturb' or airplane mode
- A 1/8" male to 1/4" male cable
- A direct box & an XLR cable

- Tracks are either purchased or rented from the MultiTracks website (Loop Community also sells tracks)
- A direct box OR an interface
